

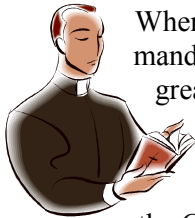

Who is my neighbor?

From the Pastor



When asked, "What is the greatest commandment?", (Matthew 22:36) Jesus said the greatest commandment was to love God, but the next was to love our neighbor. In response to the question, "Who is my neighbor?" Jesus told the story of the Good Samaritan. (Matthew 10:30-37)

Jews and the Samaritans had a history of conflict dating back for hundreds of years. They lived in close proximity to one another and yet avoided one another "like the plague". If you had asked the Jews of Jesus' day who were their enemies, the Samaritans would have been second only to the Roman occupiers. Jesus called his followers to acts of reconciliation that would transcend hatred and acts of hostility. This is something to think and pray about when we have to deal with someone who gets on our "last nerve".

Children usually transition into regular Sunday services around the first grade, based on maturity level and parent's discretion.
